Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi. 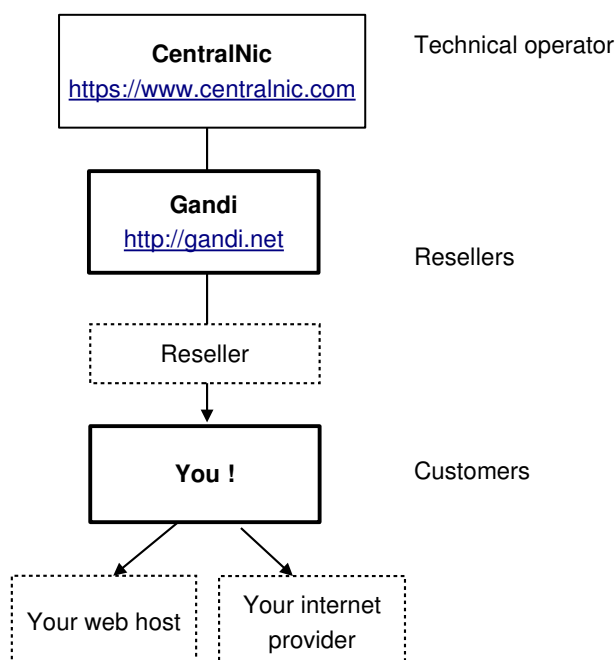
Section .CentralNic.1. Trustee authority and Registry

CentralNic's domains provide an alternative to the existing Top Level Domains (TLDs, such as .com) and Country Code Top Level Domains (ccTLDs), allowing the creation of a simultaneously local and global Internet Identity.

The idea is to make You benefit from third-level domain names (for example "mydomain.ar.com"), included inside a second-level domain name (for example "ar.com") that is operated by CentralNic. This way, You can have:

- more chances to get the name of Your choice, as the second-level is more overflowed than the third-level,
- a clear national or regional identity,
- a technical system that remains simple,
- You can avoid the specific restrictions and registration conditions of the national ccTLDs.

The following diagram presents the various parties involved for these TLDs:



You can view the information and special rules of each party involved by clicking on the respective links.

The owner of a .COM.DE domain name enters into direct contract with CentralNic, in addition to its contract with the Registrar (Gandi).

Section .CentralNic.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a CentralNic third-level domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions as defined by CentralNic, and which may be viewed at the following page:

This contract is binding between You and CentralNic. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these Rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Section .CentralNic.3. Special requirements

These third-level domain names are open to anyone. To apply to register, You must abide by the following conditions:

- the registration term is 1 up to 10 years,
- to avoid any deactivation of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **before the Expiration date**,
- You must provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-

date personal data. Failing this, CentralNic can delete Your domain name,

- names containing two characters followed by two hyphens are not allowed.

After registration, You will receive an email that confirms the registration of the domain name.

Section .CentralNic.5. Storage of contact information

You accept that CentralNic can access Your personal data and display it in the public [Whois](#) database. You can opt-out of disclosing some personal information from this public database.

Specific procedure for .COM.DE domain names (the “CentralNic Dispute Resolution Policy” does not apply):

- If CentralNic is contacted by a third party because of alleged violations of law and/or applicable rules, CentralNic will notify the domain name owner, by email, through his Registrar if applicable.
- You must process and reply to all correspondence forwarded by Gandi about a potential dispute without delay, and at least within **48 hours** (this time period may be further reduced in particular if it is curtailed by a third party), **failing this CentralNic is entitled to deactivate or delete Your domain name without any right of claim by You to refund or indemnity**. In urgent cases, CentralNic is entitled to deactivate or delete Your domain name without prior notification and

without any right of claim by You to refund or indemnity.

- With Your response, You must state whether You wish cure the alleged breach or defend You against the third party allegation.
- If You wish to defend You against the claim, You must provide CentralNic with a financial security at request. The security must be paid in cash or guarantee by a major bank or savings bank, and is used to secure CentralNic’s claims of indemnification. The amount of the security will be determined at sole discretion of CentralNic. **If You fail to provide financial security CentralNic is entitled to deactivate or delete Your domain name without any right of claim by You to refund or indemnity.**

Section .CentralNic.7. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that You have the domain’s authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar), and that Your domain name:

- does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- does not expire soon (We recommend that you start the transfer request at least one month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer’s completion requires your confirmation (by e-mail).

The transfer of a domain name does not change the domain’s Expiration date.

Trade (changing the owner and the registrar at the same time) is possible.

Section .CentralNic.8. Ownership change

The owner change can be done through a fax process (Gandi form and proofs of identity). Ownership change does not change the domain’s Expiration date.

Section .CentralNic.9. Deletion process

Upon the Expiration of the domain, We suspend (Hold) the domain name for 40 days, during which time all associated technical services are deactivated. Late renewal at normal price is possible during this period.

Then the domain name is placed on Quarantine status and can be restored, in accordance with the terms and conditions described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department. The length of the Quarantine period is 45 calendar days.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a “first come first served” basis.
