

ANNEX .PT - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .PT ccTLD

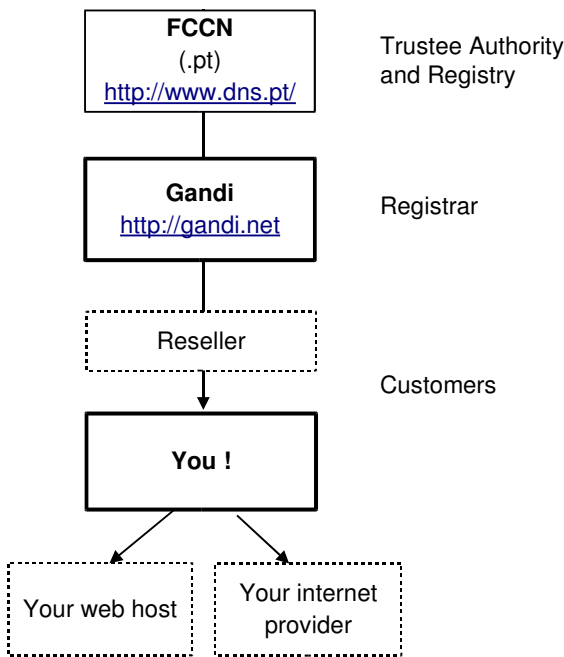

In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) for domain name registration, the registration and use of a .PT domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi. Your current contracts are freely available for viewing when You log into Your account at: <http://www.gandi.net/admin/contracts/>.

Section .PT.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.PT is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Portugal. The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .PT ccTLD:



You can view the information and special rules of each party involved by clicking on the respective links.

Section .PT.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .PT domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .PT domain names, as defined by FCCN, and which may be viewed at the following page:

This contract are binding between You and the .PT Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these Rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Section .PT.3. Special requirements

Les .PT are **restricted to organizations that have a right on the name** (the domain name must coincide with business name, or registered trademark extended to Portugal).

.COM.PT domain names are open to anyone.

Registration term

As exception to Our General Terms and Conditions of Domain Name Registration, .PT registration term is **one year**.

To avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **at least 2 days before the Expiration date**.

Eligibility requirements

To apply to register for a .PT or .COM.PT domain name, You must specify, for each domain name:

- Your status (individual or company, and if relevant Your socio-professional category),
- the reason for this domain registration,
- **for companies: Your VAT number,**
- **for individual: Your tax number.**

Except for .COM.PT, FCCN will make a posterior control to verify respect of registration rules, and notably legitimacy conditions. Under the referred control FCCN can request You documents to provide within 2 days. The non fulfillment of obligations imposed above, as well as the lack or incorrectness of data sent, shall imply the immediate removal of the domain by the Registry, without any right for indemnification.

Reserved and forbidden names

Some names are reserved, and Gandi does not provide them:

- geographical names (however this restriction does not apply to .COM.PT TLD),
- public entities names.

Some terms are forbidden for registration:

- words or expressions contrary to the law, public order or good values,
- names that may induce in error or confusion to its ownership and that are against the third parties right,
- names corresponding to any top level domain,
- names corresponding to any protocols, applications or terms of the Internet, being these understood as the ones defined by the IETF,
- names containing two followed hyphens «--» in the third and fourth positions; or names that begins or ends with a hyphen,
- name that contains less than 3 characters,
- name identical to another domain/subdomain that is not available for registration.

Section .PT.5. Storage of contact information

You accept that .PT Registry can access to Your personal data and display them in a public [Whois](#) database. You can opt-out of disclosing some personal information from this public database.

Section .PT.6. Dispute resolution policy

The Registry has set forth specific .PT domain name Alternative Dispute Resolution Policy that You agree fully abide by:

Section .PT.7. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that:

- You have the domain's authorization code (this code can only be used once and **is valid for just 30 days**) and the process number of the domain. You can retrieve these codes on the Registry's [interface](#);
- Your domain name does not expire soon. We recommend to start the transfer request at least one month before Expiration.

The transfer's completion requires your confirmation (by e-mail), and does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Trade (changing the owner during a Registrar transfer) is not available.

Section .PT.8. Ownership change

Owner changes are **not available on Our Website**. If You need to change the ownership of a domain name, please contact Our customer service department.

It is possible in some legitimate cases, mainly under a judicial or extrajudicial decision, or in case of change of company's name. For that, you will need to follow the process directly at the Registry (<https://online.dns.pt/site/publico>), and provide the requested documents and payment. Once the Registry database will be updated with the new owner name, please contact Us.

The owner change of a .PT domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .PT.9. Deletion process

One day before the Expiration date, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. All the associated technical services are deactivated. The domain **can not be renewed or restored**, it will be deleted by the Registry, and will become available for registration under the "first-come first-served" basis.
